DAY 1 YOUR JOURNEY BEGINS IN CHICAGO

DAY 6 WEST YELLOWSTONE

Highlights of this tour include Old Faithful Geyser, the Old Faithful Inn, Isa Lake on the Continental Divide, and many more stunning landmarks. After your tour, you will have time to grab lunch on your own at the Old Faithful Village. (Overnight in West Yellowstone)

DAY 7 WEST YELLOWSTONE > SALT LAKE CITY

Today, take a leisurely cruise back to Salt Lake City aboard the included shuttle. Then, the evening is yours to spend enjoying this gorgeous city. (Overnight in Salt Lake City)

DAY 8 OVERNIGHT ON BOARD AMTRAK

Discover all Salt Lake City has to offer on a guided sightseeing city tour of all of Salt Lake City's hot spots. You'll see the magnificent Salt Lake Mormon Temple and even hear the renowned Tabernacle Organ. DAY 9 SAN FRANCISCO

 population is under a million, but they're packed in, making it the second-most densely-populated city in the
 country.
- Fisherman's Wharf boasts fishing boats, sea lions basking in the sun, seafood stalls and restaurants and sourdough French bread bakeries.
- San Francisco's infamous fog is heaviest in June and July.
- San Francisco has the largest Chinatown outside of Asia and is the oldest Chinatown in North America.

Yosemite National Park

- Yosemite National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1984.
- Besides the Half Dome Yosemite National Park boasts waterfalls, deep valleys, and ancient giant sequoias.
- Yosemite National Park is open year-round, so visit in either the winter or summer and you will have a different experience during those seasons.
