TOUR ITINERARY

18 February 2025 - Okavango Delta

At Maun Airport we are met for our charter flight to Khwai Airport. Seeing the Okavango Delta from the air and the animals that call it home is something to behold. Viewing the Delta from the air gives you a great perspective of this amazing waterway and how the water floods the plains. You may be able to see elephants, hippos, zebra and many other animals during the flight as our adventure begins.

MmaTsebe Tented Camp is an authentic tented bush camp on the Mbudi River. This will be our home for the next 3 nights and includes all meals, drinks and activities.



19 & 20 February - Okavango Delta

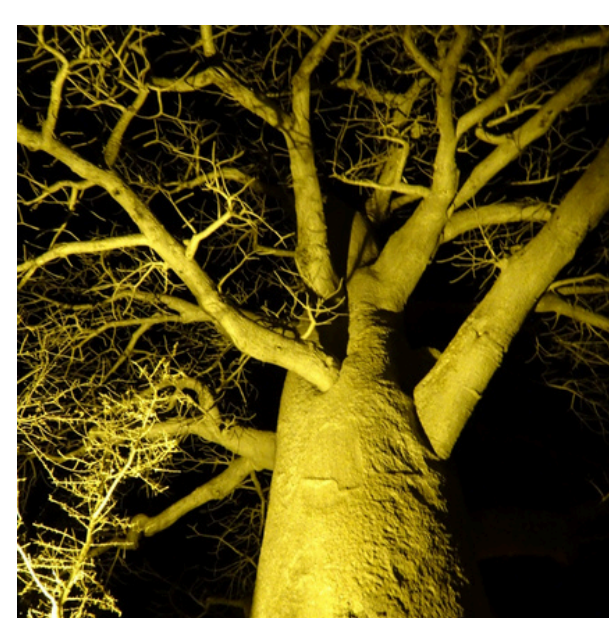
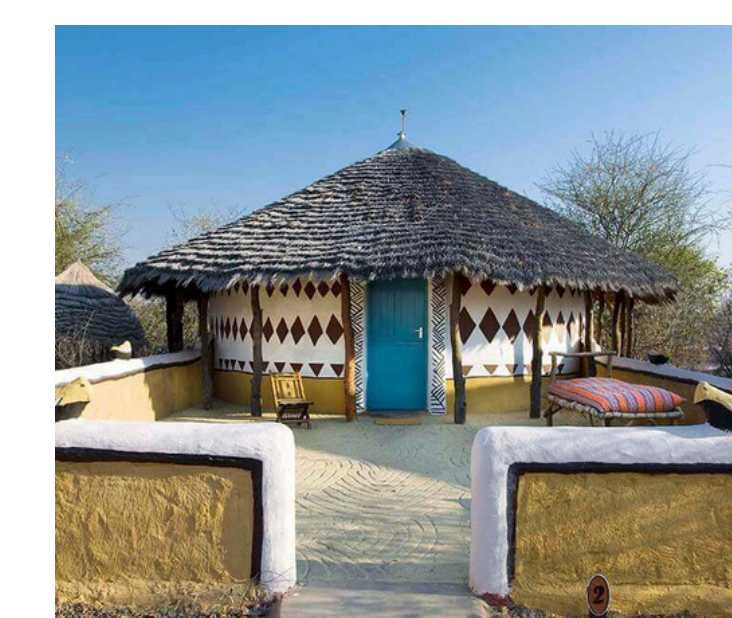
We have morning and afternoon activities in the Khwai Conservancy, these may include game drives, boat cruises, walking tours & mokoro canoes. The Okavango Delta is home to healthy populations of some of the world's most endangered large mammals, including cheetah, white rhino, leopard and lion. Botswana supports the world's largest population of elephants – 130,000 – and the Okavango Delta is considered the core area for this species' survival.

21 February - Okavango Delta to Gweta

This morning you can go on a game drive or have a leisurely breakfast before our charter flight transfer back to Maun. On arrival at Maun Airport we will be met for our road transfer to Planet Baobab (approx 2.5hrs). This afternoon we enjoy sun downers beside the Baobab Trees.

We have one night staying in the traditionally styled, beautifully painted Kalanga Huts.

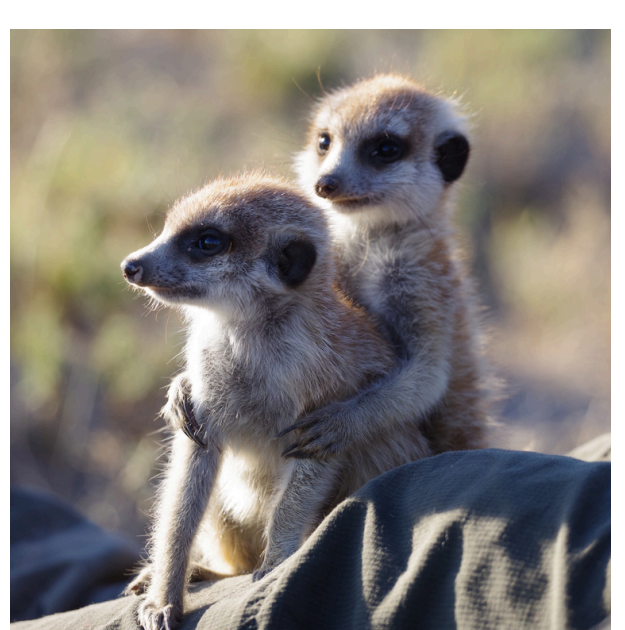
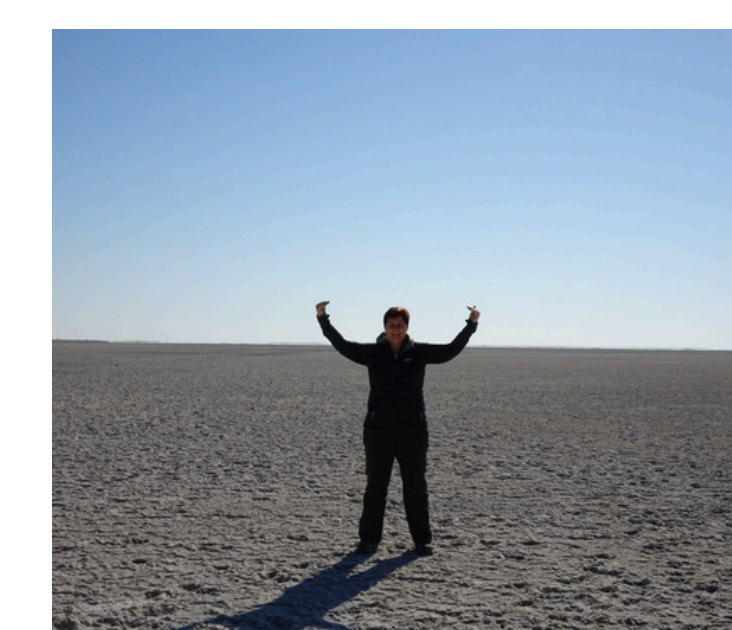
Planet Baobab - Dinner, Breakfast



22 February - Gweta - Nata

We depart in dark and make our way to the Nxai Salt Pans. Here we will meet a family of Meerkats, we arrive in time to see them waking up and warming in the morning sun. We spend some time with these cute little creatures before they head out for the day to find food. We will also do the same. Later today we depart by road to Nata (approx 1.5hrs) where we enjoy a sun downers by the Palm Trees.

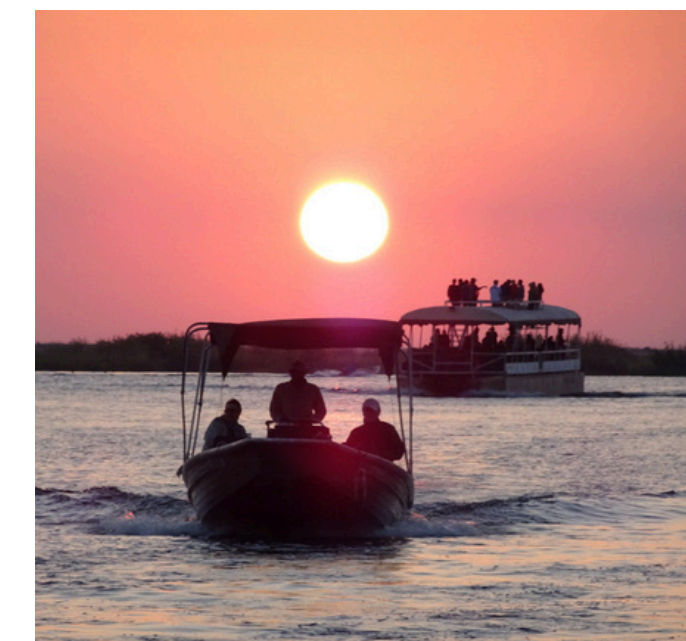
Nata Lodge - Dinner, Breakfast



23 February - Gweta - Chobe

After breakfast we hit the road and travel through central Botswana towards Chobe National Park and the Chobe River (approx 4hrs). On arrival we check into Chobe Safari Lodge for 2 nights situated in Kasane on the banks of the Chobe River. Our lodge also shares a border with Chobe National Park. This afternoon we enjoy a relaxing sunset cruise on the Chobe River followed by dinner at the lodge.

24 February - Chobe

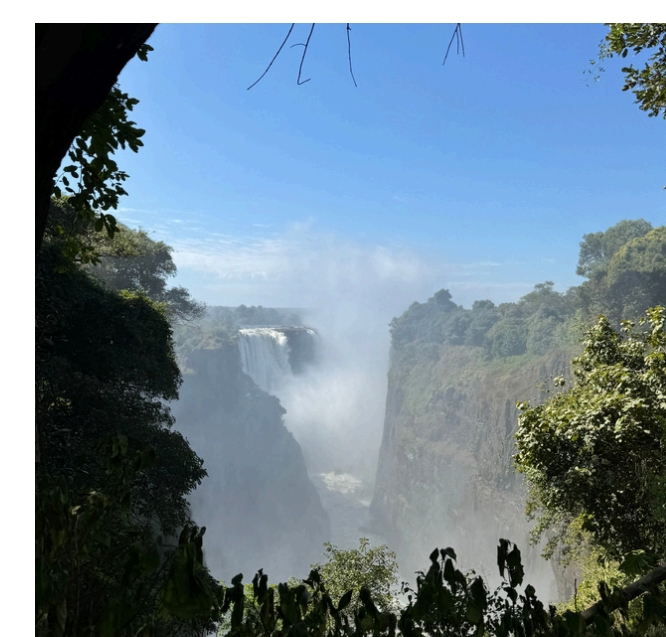
Up early for a game drive in the Chobe National Park. On our return we have breakfast and spend the middle of the day relaxing at the lodge before an afternoon cruise on the Chobe river, elephants, crocs and many other animals will be at the waters edge. Dinner is at the lodge.

25 February - Chobe - Vic Falls

Enjoy a leisurely morning or early morning game drive in Chobe NP. After breakfast we depart by road, it's a short drive to Vic Falls (approx 1.25hrs) to our lodge in the township for two nights. This afternoon is at leisure to explore Victoria Falls or relax at the lodge. Our lodge has a 2-platform lookout tower with views of the Zambezi River, and Falls' spray, the perfect place for sun downers.

26 February - Vic Falls

This morning we have a guided tour of the spectacular Victoria Falls followed by lunch at the Lookout Cafe. The Cafe overlooks the stunning Batoka Gorge and Victoria Falls Bridge. There will be time this afternoon for **optional helicopter flight over the falls** (additional cost \$355 per person - pre-booking required).

On our last evening we enjoy a sun downer cruise on the mighty Zambezi River.

This morning after breakfast we are transferred to Victoria Falls airport to either continue your journey in Africa or for your flights home.
